





Build Steps

1. Fix bulk heads to sides squarely and marry subassemblies to produce a box effect.




2. Fit the middle bulkhead in place.



3. With model inverted, attach platforms to bottom edges of bulkheads; with the bulkhead fitting into the slot in the platform.




4. Carefully bend the dash panels to fit the curve of the platform, cut to length, and fit to platform.




5. Solder the two halves of the ceiling/upper deck floor together and fit.



6. Fit the stair bases and stairs (unless wishing to paint them first).




7. Fit the upper deck sides and bulkheads.



8. Carefully bend the balcony ends and trim to fit. Note, the ends are made from American pewter and are therefore easier to bend.



9. Turn model over and fix the steps, life guards under the front panels and the life trays.



10. Solder the two halves of the roof together but do not fit to body until the interior is completed.
