


- 1. Attach truck sides to body sides ensuring exact centrality
- 2. Fix bulk heads to sides squarely and marry all subassemblies to produce a box effect



- 3. With model inverted, attach platforms to bottom edges of bulkheads; ensuring the lip is within the body and not on the platform. If necessary trim the edges of the platform to make it fit inside the car body.
- 4. Gently bend the dash panels to fit the curve of the platform, trim to length and fit to platform.



- 5. Fix the ceiling/upper deck floor piece
- 6. Attach upper deck sides to the floor. Use the 3rd strip to form a curve for the upper deck ends.



7. Turn model over and fix the steps, the life guards under the front panels and the life trays attached to the front edge of the truck sides so they do not interfere with the mechanism.



8. Fit the trolley mast.



9. Fit the stairs unless you wish to paint them first.
