



 $\frac{Build\ Steps}{1.\quad Attach\ the\ truck\ sides\ centrally\ to\ the\ saloon\ sides.}$




2. Fix one bulkhead square to each side, then join the two sub-assemblies together to create a box.



- 3. Attach the platforms centrally under the bulkheads with the rear wide sections flush with the bottom of the bulkhead. You may need to trim the edges of the platforms so that they fit inside the body.
- 4. Bend the dash panels to match the shape of the platform, trim to length so that it fits against the bulkhead and fix in place.
- 5. Gently bend the driver vestibule to match the shape of the dash and fix in place.



6. Fit the vestibule extensions to the filled in section on the lower left-hand side of the driver vestibule (when looking at the tram from the front).



7. Fit the upper floor centrally to the body.




8. Fit the upper sides and bulkheads together on a flat surface. Fit this to the centre of the upper deck floor.



9. Fit the balcony ends, bending the end panels so that they match the shape of the upper floor.



10. Turn model over to fit the steps, lifeguards and life trays.



11. Fix the destination boxes to the upper middle section of the driver vestibule.



12. Fit the stairs unless you wish to paint them first.
